

## WHAT TO BRING

Bring bedding or sleeping bag, pillow, **Bible**, flashlight, personal belongings (toothbrush, soap, towels, etc.) and a light jacket for the mornings and evenings. (We are at 7500 ft and it does get cool in the mornings and evenings.) Silver State is not responsible for lost or broken items. Pop, candy, t-shirts and other camp items can be purchased at the Country Store, Pop Stand, and Mule Barn. Cost of items range from \$.25 to \$20.00. The cost of horseback riding is \$10.00 for each half hour ride.

## MEDICAL

All medications, including over-the-counter medications, vitamins, just-in-case medications, **MUST** be given to the Camp Nurse at Check-In. This assures that correct dosages are taken and that someone else does not get into it. Please make sure that all medications are in their **original packaging**, labeled with camper's name, name of medication and correct dosage, prior to arrival. All non-prescription medications including vitamins, homeopathic medications, natural remedies and herbs must be accompanied by a physician's prescription with his/her signature in order for our camp nurse to distribute these to your child during his/her week of camp. **We cannot distribute the above items without the doctor's signature.** The Camp Nurse has ample supplies of most over-the-counter medications (i.e., Tylenol, Benadryl, Ibuprofen, Sudafed, etc.) along with first-aid kits. Please do not send these with your child unless they have allergies to common medications. All cuts, scrapes and bumps must be reported and treated by the Nurse. Campers should not be attending to their own injuries. Information and instructions for taking medication should be sent on registration card. Diabetics or others on special diets must bring their own foodstuffs if supplement beyond regular meal is desired. Please make your counselor aware of any special needs you may have.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### CLOTHING

All apparel worn at camp should be modest and show forth the highest Christian character. Jeans and casual wear is appropriate for general use. Dress-up clothes are in order for the evening services. (Girls should bring **knee-length** skirts and dresses, and boys should wear nice church attire.) **Absolutely** no shorts, walking shorts, mini skirts, stretch pants, capri pants, crop tops or tank tops are permitted. All dresses or skirts must come below the knee. Low neckline garments are **NOT** acceptable camp attire. Capri style pants are **NOT** allowed.

### MUSIC

We encourage groups and individuals to bring special music to camp. Please bring music conducive to the preaching of the Word. If you use sound tracks, choose "mellow" tracks that do not have a heavy beat or overpowering instruments. All music will be screened and could be turned down if it does not meet camp standards. No radios, tape players CD players, or 2-way radios are to be brought to camp.

### ATTENTION

No bedding or linens will be provided at camp for youth or adults! All campers must bring their own. Adult beds are queen size.

## CAMP RULES AND SPECIAL INFORMATION

1. Medical physicals **must** be done **before** coming to camp. Health Record section must be completed and signed by a doctor or physicians assistant.
2. The Silver State Baptist Youth Camp allows no bodily contact!
3. Anyone wearing questionable clothes that do not meet Christian standards will be required to change.
4. There will be a curfew hour announced during the camp week.
5. Everyone must attend **ALL** classes and all meals. No one is to leave the dining hall until everyone has been dismissed.
6. After dark, campers are to remain in the main lighted areas of the campground.
7. Everyone, including adults, must bring their own towels, washcloths and complete bedding. Also, bring a plastic bag for dirty clothes. Towels, washcloths, sheets and blankets are **not** available in any of the rooms.
8. There will be coffee available in the large dining hall on a 24-hour basis for the adults only.
9. Alcoholic beverages and tobacco is prohibited on the campground.
